What is a Student Leader?

An Upward Challenge student leader is a young person who has a passion for Jesus Christ and a desire to grow in the gifts of the Holy Spirit as well as in his or her leadership ability. The Student Leader will be responsible for a small group of youth during the week of Upward Challenge and will be a role model to the group members. The student leader will also attend the leadership meetings and debriefings during the week to gain insight and discernment in his/her role as a leader. Throughout the entire week, the Student Leaders will have different opportunities to grow in leadership and expression of their individual gifts.

- Fully commit to attending UC 2007 and the pre-event leadership meeting the day before the start date.
- Complete the two reading assignments given prior to UC 2007

Requirements for Student Leader:

- A rising 10th grader
- Having attended at least one prior Upward Challenge
- Has a current leadership role in home youth group and/or church
- Is spiritually and emotionally mature with a desire to grow in relationship with Christ and in leadership ability.

Answers to questions must be typed, single spaced. Use size 12 font.

Describe a life-changing encounter that you have had with God.

On the front page of your response include this information:
