## CONGREGATIONAL RENEWAL

### *Catching the Wind & Fire of the Spirit*

Churches go through life cycles, much like we as human being do – birth, infancy, adolescence, prime, maturity. However, the distinct difference between the church and human life-cycle is that while the human mortality rate continues to be 100%, churches do not need to die. Instead churches can launch into a new life cycle of vitality and renewal at any stage, most critically at the stage of maturity. Such congregational renewal depends directly on catching the fresh wind and fresh fire of the Holy Spirit, who brings warmth and breathes life into the church body and empowers individuals to step into ministry.

To encourage churches to grow in the person and work of the Holy Spirit, DFC offers ministries that partner with local churches for congregational renewal. The Dunamis Video Course, following the model of the Alpha course, offers trained facilitators the opportunity to share this teaching in their congregation. Three ten-week courses are available: *Experiencing the Person & Work of the Holy Spirit*, *In the Spirit's Power*, and *Prayer in the Power of the Holy Spirit*. If you are interested in being trained to facilitate the Dunamis Video Course in your congregation, please contact the DFC Office for more information.



*Ignite*, is another program expression for congregational renewal. This is a short, introductory session, typically a Friday evening and Saturday, with topics offered corresponding to those of the video courses. A team of 2-6 teachers and prayer people come to the church to share in teaching, guiding through exercises, provide prayer ministry opportunity, working with other prayer people in the church or region. An *Ignite* can be a local church event, can be for a group of churches by invitation, or can be a regional event by promotion. Churches and individuals experience vitality and grow in hope through the ministry of teaching and prayer.

## *Agency Agreement Signed*

DFC recently signed a Agency Agreement with PRMI allowing Canadian donors to fund specific projects and receive tax-deductible receipts. The Agency Agreement itself is a blanket form to which supplementary 'Schedules' are added in accordance with Revenue Canada guidelines. The first such Schedule is a joint venture to produce the fourth Dunamis Project Video—Evangelism. The anticipated cost to produce the video is roughly \$60,000.00 receiving contributions from Dunamis Fellowship UK, Alaska and Canada.

Currently the Agency Agreement only allows DFC to give charitable receipts for the Evangelism video, but it is hoped that there will be further opportunities to support the ministry of PRMI.

## Report on the Dunamis Project Held at Canterbury Hills



Dunamis Fellowship Canada's first five day Dunamis Project happened at Canterbury Hills, Ontario on March 25th to 29th. Brad Long and Cindy Strickler were the speakers for the event, the theme being "Gateways to Empowered Ministry, the Person and Work of the Holy Spirit". There were 49 people in attendance and we enjoyed the gentle, hilly, treed and idyllic location that invited us to prayer.

The burden of the conference focused on living in the Power of the Spirit, leading us to an engagement in Spirit anointed (power) ministry. Brad and Cindy addressed the Biblical witness to the Holy Spirit and its implications for ministry today. But, since our western scientific world view has infected the Church, there is need for a paradigm shift. Only then can the Church appropriate the reality of God's presence and work through the Holy Spirit for its life and work in the world, i.e. learning to cooperate with the Holy Spirit.

We were also given opportunities to practice what was being taught, engaging us in developing our ministry gifts, while also receiving ministry.
