

1. The place of recommitment to Jesus Christ



Romans 10:9

That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

John 15: 5-10

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing....As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love."

The Future Prayer Porch and Chapel

This new place, overlooking the river, beside these huge hemlock trees, has been set apart as the place of recommitment to Jesus Christ and reaffirmation of our Baptism. Here we will be building a simple prayer porch with a small screened-in prayer chapel.



Engagement in prayer happens in particular places; the Community of the Cross is one

- but this pattern may be used wherever the Holy Spirit is calling you and setting apart *your* place of prayer.

Directions for this prayer walk:

In prayer, present yourself to Jesus. Ask Him, through His Holy Spirit, to guide you in your time of prayer.

Linger on each verse as long as the Holy Spirit invites you. When He guides you to go to the next step, change your physical location

Also, as you go place to place at the COC, or wherever you may be, join us in praying that the Holy Spirit will set each of these places apart for the special prayer focus envisioned. Ask Him to provide the facilities needed for these places.

Confession, repentance, and receiving Jesus' forgiveness

1 John 1:6-10

"If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth.

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness..."



3. Accession Point Longview Prayer Chapel

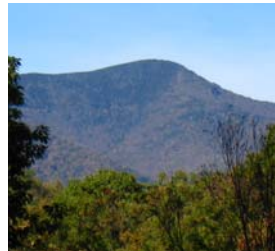
Receiving vision; being commissioned and filled with the Holy Spirit
